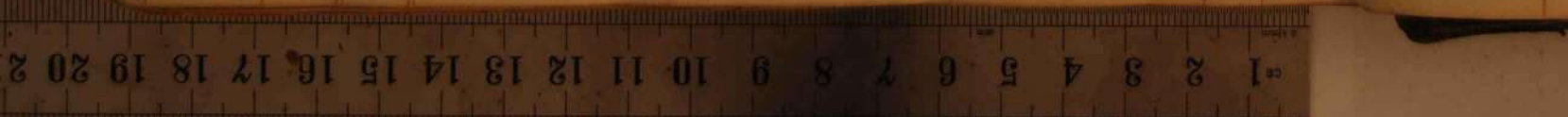

Dear Sir! With reference to our respectful letter to You and worthy Comembers, dated 26 Kislev 5592, by which we most amply gave an explicit answer on Your questions and besides made You fully informed of what some may deserve particular attentions in behalf of the Holyland, and which letter we again made direct to Your worthy name, we cannot withhold uttering our astonishment on account of Your silence on the same till now; instead we had requested at the same time for a clear and explicit answer also of Yours! Well aware of Your individual kind and honest behaviour by dispatching always an answer even to private ones, and besides as You had proved doing so formerly to ourselves, we can the less explain not having in all the interim received a single reply, even of the receipt of our said letter; and beg therefore to repeat requesting You to inform us of the consequences of aforesaid letter.

We entertained You with the same concerning the Reverend Messrs Rabbi Abraham Salomon Akenasi of Jerusalem, who then was at Paris, that we did not know what Your opinion about his Messrs would be. In the interim he arrived here and told us he could not perform anything on Your plea, on account of his predecessor the Reverend Rabbi Meel Levy, who before him received the funds ready for the HL. Now, as consequently there is nothing done at present by this way on Your plea for our poor brethren's well, it is the more on the spot, You yourself and worthy Colleague attempt immediately all exertions to make them supported here forth by the appointed preferable way, viz to cause, like we do, Societies of Subscribers for annual Contributions to be erected. And we have every reason to point out with certainty the present moment as the most fitting to move charitable feelings with the English individuals, as, alas! the much feared Cholera sickness did not actually neither exclude England (may Heaven hide from further consequences of it!). Benefacts and Charities are undoubtedly the most proved preservatives for avoiding the plague; and which Charity joins more directly Religion and retards presumption and therefore better pleases our omnipotent Father than that of supporting and assisting our poor pious brethren in the HL, who daily send prayers for our health and welfare, as there are vindicating proofs they do so? No individual will therefore refuse his Subscription for a certain annual support, a little sacrifice indeed, in order to be hid from sickness and misfortune. Please consider this circumstance and embrace the moment for so laudable a purpose, and Heaven will reward Your endeavors with continual health and happiness.

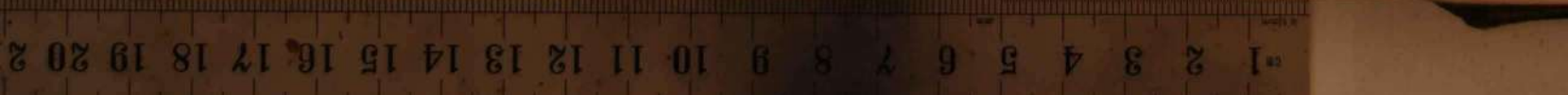

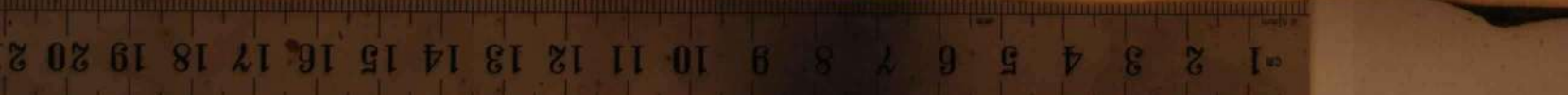

Nathan Hakohen, 200 Piasters due on the purchase of the house, 300 Piasters more for expense in the further purchase of the other buildings necessary for the Sukka and small room and 25 Piasters due for oil offered for You by Mr. Joseph Dubna. I beg, dear Sir, to be persuaded I am exceedingly joyful in behalf of the said respective Receivers and pay many anticipatory thanks on their name for Your Cordial expedition fulfilling of their wishes, and have immediately received Your £20:10, purchased on Receipt against it and already remitted the produce to Trieste in order to be divided quite according to Your orders.

As as You did not prescribe any Quantum of part for the son of R. Traub Perez out of the 10 sent together for them, I stood again on Your former disposition, and ordered to pay him 200 Grosches out of this sum, I suppose this to be Your intention, if not, please to let me know it, in order I care for altering this Disposition.

As for Your argument of wanting (besides that from Teberia, expected to come afterwards) also the receipt from Hebron at ten pounds, we had indeed supposed this to be in Your hands already, but now hastened to search for it amongst the H^h papers, and in fact have found the same yet with us, wherefore beg Your pardon for the mistake, having the honor to hand it to You here enclosed.

Most aware and persuaded of Your liking to continue Your benefacts to the individuals who have received them already formerly, I dare not to withhold reminding You also again Mr. Alexander Plitz in Jerusalem who uttered us thousand blessings on You for the fruits of Your good heart he already enjoyed of, and requested us particularly to communicate his hoping to remain remembered with You for sake of benevolence.

I feel much obliged for Your kindness and wishes and pay them by giving You pay on account of Your multiplying benefacts for sake of our poor Brethren in the H^h; a continual ability to bestow the same in good health and happiness, is the wish of

Dear Sir:

Your much esteemed favor of the 2^d Decar from Namgate (last City day)
I had the satisfaction to receive the 7th of same month, and request your accepting
my best thanks for so many expressions of politeness and friendship it contained
towards me and my worthy Colleagues.

You had been pleased to oblige me in the same Your intention, to return to London
for Perim, when you should have a meeting with your excellent Colleagues
and then give us the honor of your kind description; besides this, you were
kind enough to add, that I might rely upon your utmost endeavors being
executed (in which you know you shall be warmly joined by your worthy
Colleagues, the moment you return to London).

These most fervent and Compunctive Preliminaries afforded with me the
fixed expectation, we should have the satisfaction of receiving after Perim
your promised kind rescript, on our letter of the 26th of March, notwithstanding we
remained in all the interim deprived from the pleasure of seeing this ex-
pectation realized, and cannot in fact explain to ourselves what might
have been the Cause of your delay!

I give me leave to oblige you in reply, dear Sir, with reference to the Cheri-
table feelings and ability of the English Individuals towards our brethren
in the Hk, that I mean not to be extravagant if I expect much of them
they being very benificent and generous on many other subjects, and
chiefly I dare expect the best fruits of this as the Care and attempts
for it could not be trusted to better hands than to those of excellent
Gentlemen like you. I know besides by own experience what is owing
to produce by utmost and warm endeavors, as I have personally
visited a considerable part of the Continent and was happy enough to
gather sweet fruits of my exertions every where. As I had also
intended to visit England for the good purpose in this interim, from
which I have been however withheld on account of the Cholera, which
mean while extended itself also there. I hope notwithstanding I need not
to fear, my absence will deprive the purpose of the wanted favorable
issue, as I repeat to say, the Care for it is trusted to very good hands.

According to Conferences I had with the Reverend Jewish Rabbi Abm
Salomon Benkenari of Jerusalem, I believe I might suppose as a Cause
of your delaying to carry your labours into effect, that perhaps you
remain wanting previously the ratifying Acknowledgment of your
Quality from the Hk. - Allow me, if this be the matter in fact, to
obscure thereabout that there is surely no reason to have any doubt
on the arrival of this Acknowledgment, and therefore to postpone pro-
ceeding the good plan.

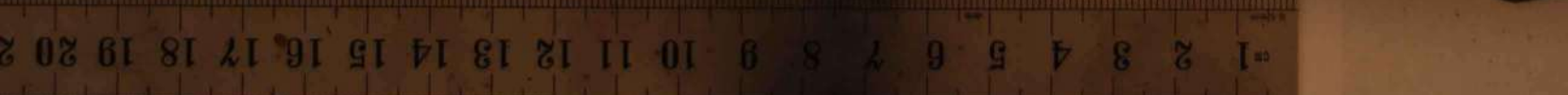

Dear Sir!

I received in due time Your esteemed favor of 8th Inst. with the enclosed L^d Bank of England note, which we have sold for 59.87 $\frac{1}{2}$ and, according to Your Order, immediately paid from this amount 17.50 to Mess^{rs} Rabius & Co and carried the remainder after deduction of postage, as You ordered likewise, to the credit of our beloved Mr. Alexander Hite at Jerusalem. I beg to pay Your cordial thanks on his name and at the same time to refute Your supposition of his not being in such a want of it; of course there are other individuals in poorer circumstances than he, but not however suppose he perhaps his most needful without wanting also Your assistance. We know indeed that small amount we annually remit to him; besides, which he receives his part or share from the Kolelim, and that is all. Some time ago he informed us, You had asked him when You were in Jerusalem how much he was owing; 25 Dollars replied he. Afterwards the son of N. Hoac in Tephath told You there were 25 Dollars ready for him with the memento at Tephath. But, for shame, he did not tell You his owing besides 25 Dollars more, like we had been accordingly informed by N. Adlerle of Tephath who paid last summer a visit for several weeks to Mr. Hite in Jerusalem, that on account of sickness and other circumstances, Mr. B. was a debtor for 600 groshes, and, added he, a debt in the 11th increases very soon an amount of the considerable interests. In consequence of all this, You see, Dear Sir, Your benevolent beneficence has been very well bestowed on him.

Please to excuse my not having replied to You sooner; the continual business of Correspondance for sake of the W^{ch}, gives often way to remain due for an answer notwithstanding I long since had intended to reply and utter than my grief for Your having quite kept silence on my former observations with reference to Your proposals to the meeting, which induces me to doubt, whether my words had formed an entrance with You.

Now this day I have the honor to receive Your favor of 25th Inst, observing, my silence induces You to enquire if I had received Your letter of the 8th Inst. with the enclosed B. N. of 5th: I therefore dispatch to affirm it, and as I could not write to Amsterdam before next Monday, I send this present by the male or packet.

I am sorry to learn, You are not being as yet able to give me any good news respecting the Society for the W^{ch}. You remain however keeping the debt silence respecting my former observations. I get ever more convinced there would be no better and more becoming mean for the purpose but my coming myself to London; which in fact was my intention to do with this aim this summer, but the calamity of the Cholera, which visited Your place, and the circumstance of the arriving letters being carried yet, which gives an appearance the sickness not to have quite left the place till now, withholds me from carrying my aim into effect. Mean while it grieves me to understand, the matter cannot go well without my presence and I hope it may alter and reach a better end like it heartily, wished by
